## *Are You Ready for the Energy-Environment Challenge?*

The Environmental Science and Public Policy program, in coordination with the Harvard University Center for the Environment, is pleased to offer the Secondary Field in Energy and Environment (E&E). Students will increase their exposure to, and literacy in, the interdisciplinary and interconnected issues related to energy and the environment while maintaining their focus in their home concentrations. Through debate and dialogue in coursework and seminars, students will identify the obstacles, recognize the opportunities, and define the discussion for an energy-environment strategy for the 21st century and beyond.

### **REQUIREMENTS (4 HALF COURSES)**

Students choose one foundational E&E course, which includes content related to both energy and environment, and three other upper-level courses divided between two categories: Social Sciences/Humanities, and Natural Sciences/Engineering. ### **FACULTY**

The E&E secondary field is overseen by the ESPP Board of Tutors, and student advising is provided by members of the broad HUCE faculty community.
