



2017 Call for Max Planck Research Groups 18 Sep. – 18 Oct. 2017

From September 18 - October 18, 2017, a new international announcement for open-topic Max Planck Research Groups will be made by the Max Planck Society. The Max Planck Institute for the Structure and Dynamics of Matter (MPSD) <http://www.mpsd.mpg.de/> offers to host two research groups in this call. One of those groups would be embedded within the Condensed Matter Dynamics Department and the other group in the Theory Department.

Selected candidates will receive the possibility to run their group for 5 years at a Max Planck Institute of their own choice, starting earliest at the beginning of 2019. After having successfully passed evaluations, the groups can be extended twice by two years. The group leader positions are remunerated at the level of an Associate Professor without tenure. Financial resources also include generous start-up funds.

The public call will take place jointly for all three Scientific Sections of the Max Planck Society (Biology & Medicine; Chemistry, Physics & Technology; Humanities & Social Sciences). Subsequently, the candidates will be asked to choose a Section in advance of submitting an application.

A respective announcement will be placed in selected international job markets as well as on online platforms starting September 18, 2017.
