



Senior Thesis Research Grant

The Charles Warren Center, Harvard's research center for North American history, awards 4-6 summer fellowships to Harvard College juniors undertaking a thesis in American history. The proposed thesis research must be centered in American history and the methodology must be primarily historical. Undergraduates in any concentration are encouraged to apply.

The grants' purpose is to enable students to spend a significant period of time on thesis research during the summer before the senior year. The award amount is commensurate with the research budget, up to a maximum of \$2,500.
