This postdoctoral position will report to the USC Roybal Institute Executive Director, Dr. Aranda working closely with the Center for Hispanic Health at Adventist Health White Memorial to (1) participate with a team of multidisciplinary researchers focused on the substantive area of patient- and family-centered translational healthcare research; (2) develop innovative extramural research projects that support the well-being and health of individuals and families from Latino communities; and (3) establish a record of peer-reviewed, scientific scholarship in the substantive area in order to enhance the postdoctoral scholar's career development.

Requirements

Applicants must have completed their PhD within the last 5 years. Applicants who do not have the PhD in hand at the time of application must provide during their interview a letter from the department chair or the advisor stating when the PhD degree will be conferred. The selected candidate will be required to provide official documentation from the institution that issued the degree prior to the appointment.

Qualifications

The successful candidate should have earned a Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent advanced degree by the time of appointment or within the last five years in social work, gerontology, medicine, nursing, psychology, or related health services research field.

- Demonstrated strong background in quantitative analysis including experience and proficiency using Cloudera or similar software packages
- Experience with administrative health datasets and data linkage
- Ability to learn and understand clinical issues
