The program is especially interested in research that explores parallels between the cognitive mechanisms involved in perceptual judgments and in economic decisions. Projects may involve the perception of probability, value or risk; models of online inference; learning to forecast or categorize; endogenous allocation of attention; sources of randomness in decisions; or context effects in choice behavior.

Minimum Qualifications: a PhD in economics, psychology, computational neuroscience, computer science, or related field. A strong background in computational modeling is preferred.
