

# Post-Doctoral Fellowships

Israel Institute post-doctoral fellowships are available for newly minted Ph.D.s in the United States interested in a long-term academic focus on modern Israel from the United States.

## Post-doctoral grants available

Post-doctoral fellowships support promising doctoral graduates with invitations from top universities to conduct and publish research, engage in public events, and receive mentoring while preparing for tenure-track university positions.

#### REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must have completed their doctoral degrees in the last three years or by September 1, when the fellowships begin; have dissertations about Israel; and plan to maintain Israel as a research focus.
- Post-doctoral fellows are awarded up to \$60,000 per academic year.
- Fellowships may be extended for a second year subject to available funding and provided fellows meet explicit criteria for publishing and speaking.
