



Fulbright-Israel Institute Post-Doctoral Fellowship

This fellowship supports promising American doctoral graduates researching modern Israel who have unfunded invitations for post-doctoral fellowships at top universities in Israel.

Post-doctoral grant available

The fellow is awarded up to \$40,000 per academic year to conduct research and publish at an Israeli university. The award may be renewed for a second year, pending the scholar's productivity and available funds.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- have dissertations about Israel and plan to pursue academic careers in the United States with Israel as a research focus:
- have invitations for a post-doctoral fellowship from an Israeli university; and
- have completed their doctoral degrees after April 2016 and by September 1, when the fellowship begins.
